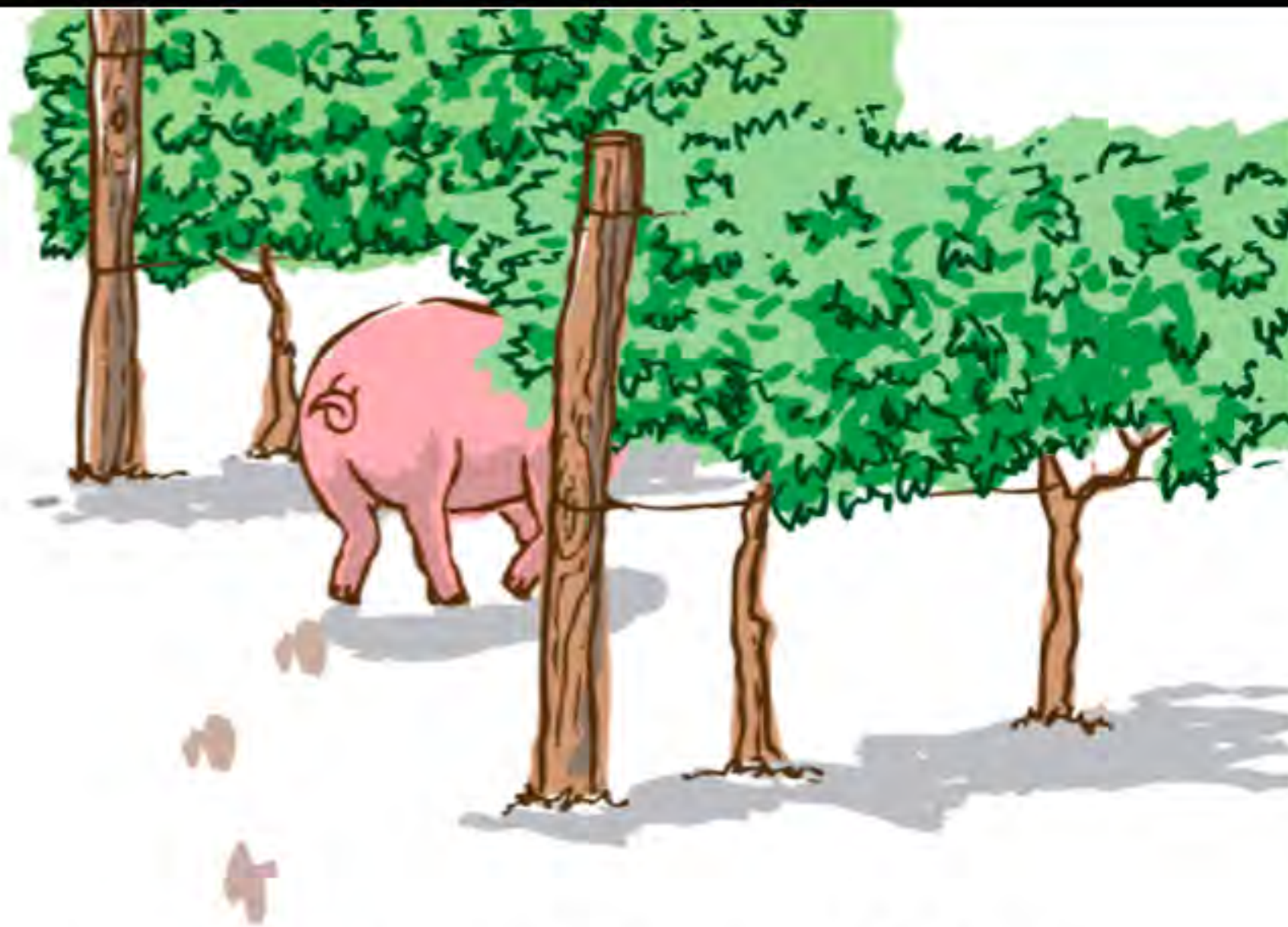

In 1997 he began at Viña Concha y Toro and would later become a winemaker for Casillero del Diablo. Marcio currently carries out his work in the Rapel Valley, specifically in Peumo. His hard work and commitment, alongside the extraordinary soil and climate conditions in the region, have allowed for the development of excellent red wines, particularly Chile's emblematic variety: Carmenere.

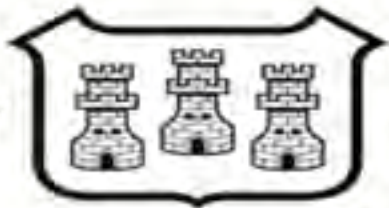

GRAND VIN DE BORDEAUX

Château de Parenchère rises in the heart of a green and hilly landscape situated 38 km from Saint-Emilion at the crossroads of the Gironde and the Dordogne departments. Mars Shinshu is Japan's highest whisky distillery, over 2600 feet. The distillery was in the Tsunuki region of Kagoshima Prefecture on the southern-most island of Kyushu about 798 meters. It founded by Hombo family and added whisky to their repertoire in 1949. They decided to move their Kyushu distillery to the picturesque alpine Miyada village for the high altitude and cool climate for suitable conditions for whisky making. The whisky is produced from water that pass-through granite rock which contains high in natural minerals.

He directed building the Yamazaki, the first whisky distillery and involved in the production of Yamazaki whisky. He left Kotobukiya in March 1934. He established his own company, Dai Nippon Kaju (later Nikka) and based in Yochi in Hokkaido. Yochi Distillery started distillation in 1936. The first Nikka Whisky, short for "Nippon Kaju" was launched in 1940 which later became the name of the company in 1952.

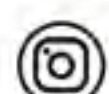

Chugoku Jozo master blenders only performed the operations of aging and blending. Togouchi whisky is diluted with water drawn from mountains in Sandankyo Natural Park after maturation in cask. Then, the whisky matured in sherry and brandy casks at abandoned railway tunnel with a length 361 meters which was constructed in 1970 by JR Japanese railway company.

White Oak Distillery was created in 1984 when the whiskey consumption was completely local. White Oak whisky is only in operation for one month every year so their production is very small. The first Akashi release was in 2007.

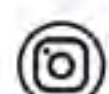
